- A. Bid Opening has been extended until **Monday, July 26 at 10am**. **Sealed bids are due at the office of the RCDSCC located at 820 Bay Avenue, Suite 136, Capitola, CA 95010, by 10:00 am on Monday, July 26, 2021**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. All social distancing requirements will be adhered to during the bid opening.
 - B. Engineers estimate is \$240,000 - \$260,000
 - C. Waterways Consulting Inc., project engineer, will provide construction staking.
 - D. Final designs are attached.
 - E. Technical Specifications are attached.
 - F. Addendum to the Geotechnical Report is attached, clarifying the need for blending of materials for berm/embankment construction.
 - G. No water is available on-site. Contractor is responsible for providing water from off-site for compaction and/or dust control.
 - H. During the pre-bid meeting, there was a discussion about the RCD providing a potential disposal site without fees. Contractor will be responsible for identifying and appropriate disposal site for excess material, for fees associated with disposal, and per technical specification 312316, Stripping and Excavation.
 - I. Anticipate saturated soils and potential subsurface water.
 - J. Remove all trees and their rootwads within the project footprint shown to be removed on the drawings. If eucalyptus trees within the “potential eucalyptus area” and/or “secondary vegetation disposal area” are removed to facilitate construction, then there is an option to remove the rootball or leave the stump in place with treatment in accordance with the tree removal notes shown on Sheet C2 and technical specification 311100, Clearing and Grubbing. If other native tree species require removal to facilitate construction, they may be cut to the ground surface and no herbicide treatment will be required.



K. Compaction testing to be performed by the owner in accordance with technical specification 312323, Engineered Fill.

L. Labor Compliance

- This is a public works project and subject to prevailing wage.
- Pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the California Labor Code, all Contractors and their Subcontractors MUST be registered with the DIR prior to bidding on this contract, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).
- No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. Contractors MUST be a registered “public works contractor” with the DIR AT THE TIME OF BID. Where the prime contract is less than \$15,000 for maintenance work or less than \$25,000 for construction alternation, demolition or repair work, registration is not required.
- Contractor will be required to upload payroll and labor compliance documents to DIR website AND submit to RCD’s labor consultant – CCMI .
